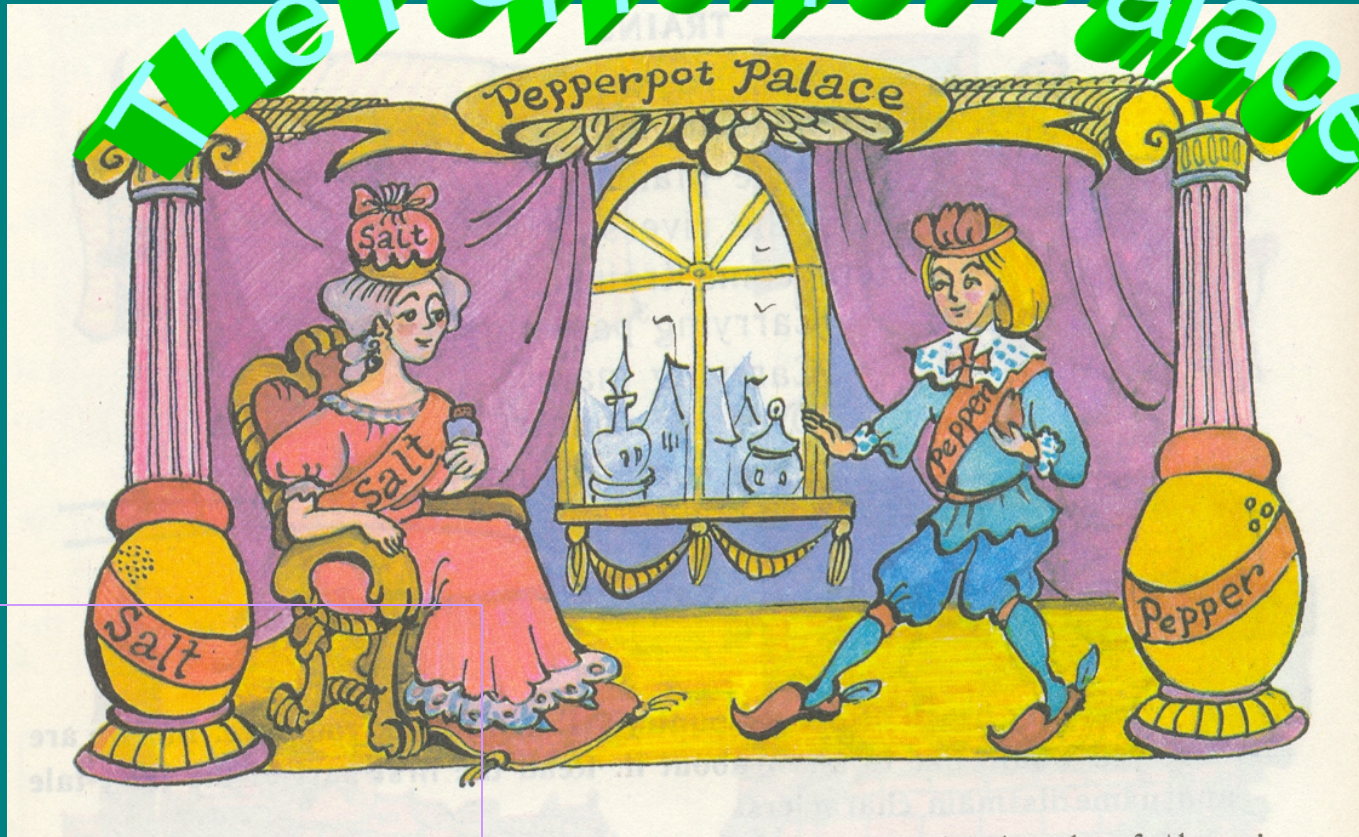

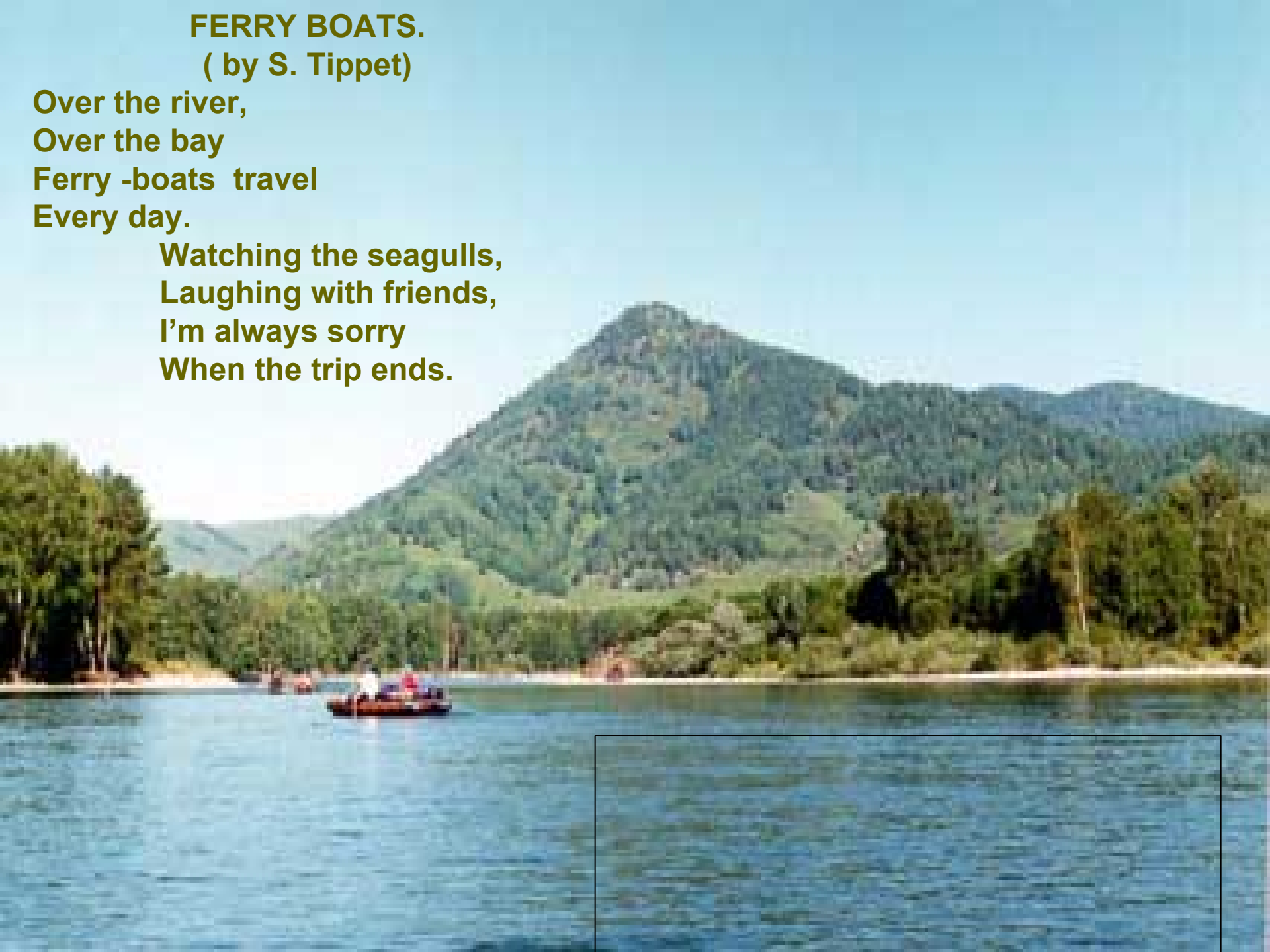

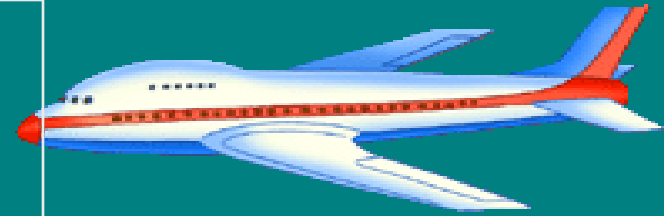
FERRY BOATS.

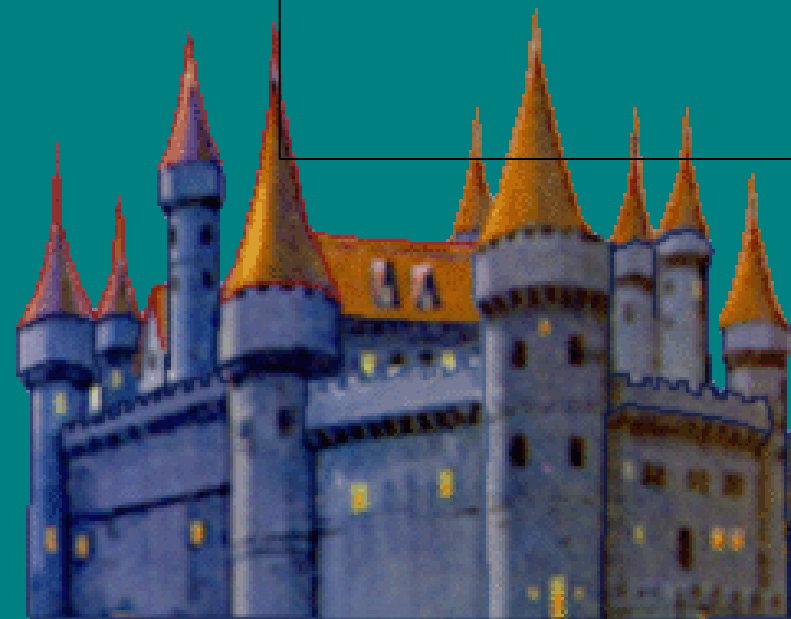

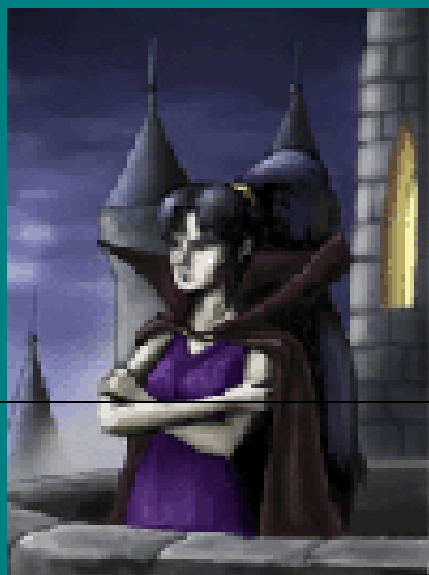

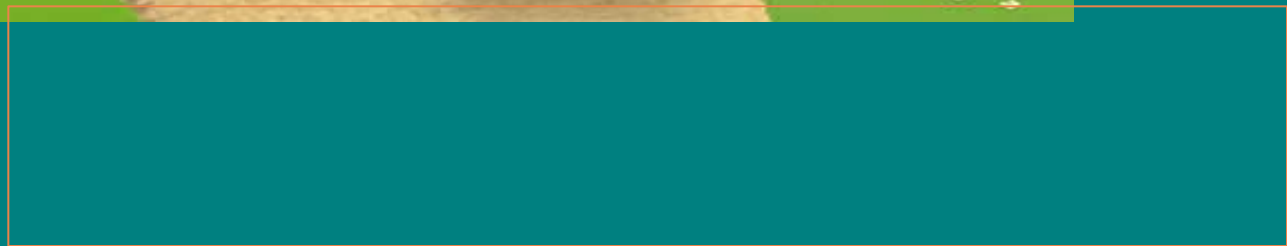
