Technical requirements for the design of scientific articles:

- 1) Text of the manuscript (article) should be in the format .doc or .RTF
- 2) Parameters of the text editor:
 - page format - «A4»,
 - fields (top, bottom, left, right) – 2,3 cm
 - font format — Times New Roman;
 - color – black;
 - font size (size) – 14;
 - line spacing – 1,5;
 - width alignment;
 - paragraphal indentation – 1,25 cm;
barring of hanging lines
- 3) In the text should not be:
 - double space between words;
 - line break mark ;
 - automatic word wrap;
 - sparse or compressed inter-letter spacing
- 4) References to sources of information in the text of the manuscript are given in square brackets in the order of quoting in Arabic numerals.
- 5) Footnotes, notes, formulas, text tables - size 12.
- 6) Availability of a list of literature is required.
- 7) Figures in the .jpg format are placed in the text of the article, and also sent as separate files (see Appendix)
- 8) Diagrams in Excel format are placed in the text of the article, and also sent as separate files (see Appendix)
- 9) The tables are placed in the text of the article in Word format (see Appendix).
- 10) The formulas are placed in the text of the article in the editor of MS Equation.
